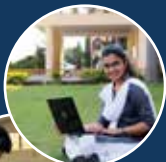

## STUDENT EXCELLENCE & LEARNING PROGRAM



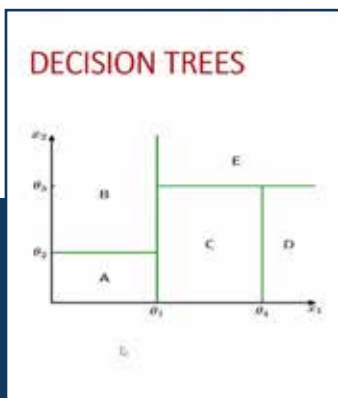
